## **Committee meeting of the British Liquid Crystal Society**

- 1. **Chair statement**: NM explained that the main purpose of this meeting is to go through the list of actions from the previous meeting and discuss future course. NM to set-up regular committee meetings three times a year and the next one will be in December this year.

  - (d) BLCS annual training workshop: DC updated that the 2022 BLCS annual training workshop was a success. DC is preparing to submit an application to EPSRC for further funding in September. The logistics of the proposal were discussed.
  - (e) NM and team have finalised the advert for the BLCS distinguished visiting lecturer scheme. The advert has been circulated to the BLCS society and is available on the BLCS website.
  - (f) TS and JD will discuss the strategy for publicising the society and provide updates at the next committee meeting.
  - (g) Prize committee suggestions: As suggested by the prize giving committee the steering committee agreed to increase the prize money for the Young scientist prize. The steering committee thought that the conference organizers should take the freedom to consider fee waive and support towards travel and accommodation for prize winners.
